Dear Key Stage Two Parents and Carers,

Spring Musical Evening

Our **15th** annual KS2 Spring Concert is on **Wednesday 1st April at 6.00pm**. Your child is involved as part of the choir, part of the brass (Y4 Whole Class as well as small group) or woodwind tuition, or because he/she learns an instrument at home and has volunteered to perform. I first introduced these evenings in 2006 during my second year as Head Teacher and I am very proud that we have had so many enjoyable evenings successfully engaging so many children in musical performance.

There are around 70 children involved from KS2. Due to Health and Safety restrictions on numbers allowed in the hall, we are limiting the number of people able to attend. In the first instance, **2 tickets per family involved in the concert** will be available, although there will be some spare. Please indicate below how many tickets you require, including any extras if there are any available. There will be a charge of £1 per ticket which goes towards supporting music in school. Please return the slip below with the money by **Monday 23rd March**. After this date, spare tickets will be allocated to those who require them. All children attending full-time school will get to see a separate performance for school during the day; if at all possible we ask that you don't, therefore, bring younger siblings to the evening concert. If they do come, they **MUST** be counted in the ticket allocation. At the close of the concert we will be serving refreshments and there will also be a raffle and/or a tombola (**any donations of prizes will be gratefully received**). We do hope that someone will be in the audience for every child taking part, but if you do not require tickets, you still need to sign below to give permission for your child to attend the event and to agree to collect them afterwards, as it will be around 7pm.

Nearer the time your child will be lent a school tie to wear, so I would really appreciate it if you could provide them with a white shirt or blouse with a proper collar for the concert, not a polo shirt.

Previous concerts have been thoroughly enjoyable evenings for all concerned, lasting around an hour. I do hope you will be able to attend and look forward to seeing you here on **Wednesday 1st April at 6.00pm**.
